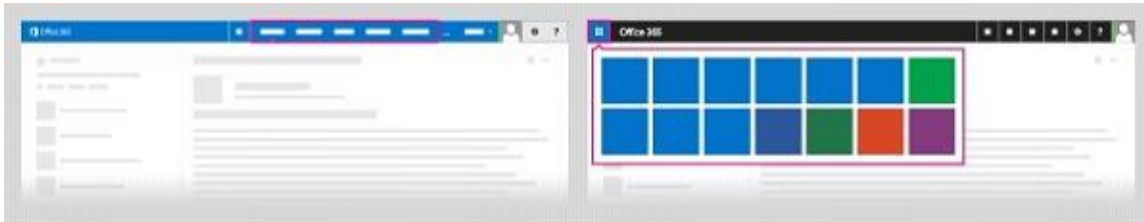

A: Office 365 users and admins can also use delivery reports in Outlook Web App to check the delivery status of messages they've sent or received. If you sent a message to five people, for example, you can check the status of the delivery of that message to each person.

Go to Delivery reports settings:

Sign in to Outlook Web App.

At the top of the page, select Outlook (or Mail). Or, select the App launcher , and then select Outlook.



Office 365 navigation options

At the top of the page, select Settings Settings icon > Options. In Options, select Organize email > Delivery reports. Or, in Options, under MAIL > Layout, select Delivery reports.
